Mission:

Since we get to meet our children only once in a week, it is not possible for us to cover different aspect of Islam but we will try to give them brief idea about Islam, Hifzul Qur'an and Ibadah.

Our Goals:

- We want our children to recite the Qur'an correctly
- We want our children to be the true and practicing believers of Islam with the proper knowledge of the teachings of Islam
- We want our children to develop character, better manners, and a respectful demeanor
- We want our children to represent Islam and be able to relate to Islamic
- beliefs and teachings to the society in a coherent way

A Brief Description of Friday School

We have a set program and well-defined Curriculum Alhamdulillah. Our dedicated and talented staff of volunteer teachers will follow the Curriculum, and also include topics related to the Islamic Calendar during the school session.

- The class will be held on Friday between 09:00 to 10:35 AM.
- There will be 2 age groups
 - 8 to 11 years
 - 12 to 16 years
- There will be a separate section for the Boys & Girls.
- The course duration will be Six months.
- There will be 24 classes.
- Class duration will be approximately 1:30 hours with 20 minutes break.
